## Rules and Important Info

- 1. The cost of the event is \$30 to register unlimited models. There are no "exhibition only" loopholes to avoid the fee. Admission is free for guests who do not bring any models to display. There are no charges for ages 17 & under to attend or register any models.
- 2. Registration forms must be completed for each displayed model. Forms may be downloaded and filled out before or at the event.
- 3. Models are to be displayed at the designated table with their corresponding class. The show staff reserves the right to assign class placement to suit the qualifications. We also reserve the right to reject any displays with vulgarity as this is a family-friendly event.
- 4. Except for the group build class, all work must be done by the individual. Displayed works of others must be registered under the actual builder's name. Please indicate whether another party completed partial work on your registration form. Work performed by others does not disqualify you. Those parts will not be judged.
- 5. The event staff will appoint judges. Entries will be judged on quality craftmanship, degree and difficulty of modifications, and overall appearance of the finished product. Winners will be determined by a point system for the following categories: paint/finish, engine, chassis, interior, trunk, and modifications. Judges will be appointed in groups of three or more. Judges will not be allowed to judge a class they are participating in.
- 6. There will be a NO SWEEPS rule for all classes.
- 7. Models may need to be picked up for judging or relocating. Please indicate on your registration form if it is fragile in any way. The event staff accepts no claims of responsibility for any damage that may occur during this event.
- 8. Participants will refrain from disturbing or influencing judges before, during, or after judging. All judges' decisions are final and non-negotiable.
- 9. Models must be complete. There will be no "project class" or exhibition area.

# Class Breakdown

### THERE WILL BE AN AWARD FOR THE "BEST" AND TWO "OUTSTANDING" AWARDS IN EACH OF THE FOLLOWING CLASSES.

- 1. Lowrider: Any vehicle with wire wheels and a simulated hydraulic or airbag setup.
- 2. Lowrider Bomb: Pre-55 vehicles. The suspension must be lowered. Stock or aftermarket wheels are acceptable. No wheels larger than 16" will be considered a bomb.
- 3. Lowrider Truck. Any truck with wire wheels and a simulated hydraulic or airbag setup. This includes vans and SUV's.
- 4. Lowrider Curbside: Only paint, interior, and final fit/assembly will be judged. Doors, trunks, and hoods must remain closed.
- 5. Lowrider Radical: Vehicle with one extensive body change or a minimum of four (4) major modifications.
- 6. Lowrider Club Build. This is open to any lowrider built by more than one person. Clubs are invited to form a team for bragging rights. This is eligible for Best in Show. If one thing was contracted out (such as paint, or interior), this is the place for it to compete.
- 7. Import: Any import or domestic compact car of any level of modifications.
- 8. Import Curbside: Only paint, interior, and final fit/assembly will be judged. Doors, trunks, and hoods must remain closed.
- 9. Dub: Any custom vehicle with 20" or larger wheels.
- 10. Texas Slab: This is the Houston style featuring "swangas" or "elbows" styled wheels.
- 11. Kustom: Any vehicle with body alterations so it is no longer stock in appearance. Factory concepts or experimental cars will be included.
- 12. Curbside: Only paint, interior, and final fit/assembly will be judged. Doors, trunks, and hoods must remain closed.
- 13. Hot Rod 1948 & Older. Any non-factory stock street-legal vehicle. No slicks allowed.
- 14. Street Machine: 1949 & Newer. Any non-factory stock street-legal vehicle.
- 15. Street Truck: Any street-legal truck, including SUVs, El Camino-style vehicles, and vans.
- 16. Minitruck: Any street-legal compact truck.
- 17. Factory Stock: Any vehicle built to factory standards. Aftermarket detail items are allowed including but not limited to engine wiring/plumbing, seat belts, and decals. Modifications such as opened doors are also allowed. Box stock builds are also invited to participate here.
- 18. Commercial Vehicle: Light or Heavy commercial vehicles such as police, towing, delivery, and big rigs.
- 19. Competition: Open and closed wheel vehicles designed to compete on a track of any sort.
- 20. Motorcycle: Open to motorcycles of any scale and any level of detail.
- 21. Miscellaneous: Any vehicle that doesn't suit any other class, ie. post-apocalyptic, sci-fi, etc.
- 22. Large Scale: Any model 1/20 scale or larger. Any level of detailing is allowed.
- 23. Junior: For entrants of ages of 17 and under.
- 24. Custom Hot Wheels: Open to any level of customizing and added accessories.
- 25. Gunpla: Gundam Plastic Models. 1/144 scale. Open to any level of detailing.
- 26. Gunpla: Gundam Plastic Models. 1/100 or larger scale. Open to any level of detailing.
